[Spotin \(Spotlight on Innovation\)](#) is a Greek non-profit organization founded in 2021, specializing in geo-education, digital map-making and geo-storytelling. Through the Panhellenic School Map Competition, EU-funded projects, student and teacher training programmes and open-access educational material, Spotin designs interdisciplinary, project-based learning experiences that connect people to the world through maps.

Until today, Spotin has trained over **3.380 students and teachers** and collaborated with more than **200 schools** across Greece and abroad.

ABOUT THE MAP COMPETITION



The Panhellenic Map Competition is a national school competition on digital map-making and geo-storytelling, organized annually by Spotin since 2021. Each edition invites primary and secondary school students across Greece and Greek schools abroad to explore a real-world social, environmental, historical or cultural theme through field research, digital maps and geo-narratives.

The Competition has a two-fold goal: (a) developing teachers' and students' digital and spatial skills through hands-on geo-technology training and (b) raising awareness around each year's theme - from refugee stories and water management to urban accessibility and local heritage. Participation is free and GIS software licenses are made available at no cost to all participating schools upon request.

Until today, the Competition has engaged over 180 schools, 2.800 teachers and students and produced more than 260 student projects, all published in the **Map Competition Digital Library of School Projects**:
